### Principal Report

#### Parent Teacher Interviews


You should receive a link today inviting you to parent/teacher interviews for next week. If there are no suitable time slots available, please contact your child's class teacher to organise a mutually acceptable time. This year we are offering both face-to-face and phone interviews.

#### NAPLAN

NAPLAN testing commenced last week for our Year 3 and Year 5 students. As I had previously informed you there are changes to the way student results are reported on. Previously children were scored on a continuum of bands from 1 to 10. Now reporting will be on a year level and your child will be placed in either Exceeding, Strong, Developing or Needs Additional Support for each of the tests that they complete. I have included a screenshot of part of a sample report that was published in the Sydney Morning Herald last week. To date this is the only information that I have.

#### Canteen

Despite having applied for the canteen tender for the Port Kembla Public School canteen at the end of last year, the owner of Fresh Start Canteens have now informed us that our canteen is not profitable for her and is therefore closing our canteen. The last day of trading will be this Friday 24th March. I am incredibly disappointed that this has happened and feel that the school has been let down by Fresh Start Canteens and apologise to you all for the inconvenience it will cause many and the disappointment it will cause our students. I am in discussion with Schools Infrastructure to see if we can find another canteen operator, but not feeling hopeful about that. I informed the P&C last Wednesday night and they will be discussing some possible alternatives at future meetings. If you have any unused credit in your QuickCliq account, please either spend it to order this week or see below on how to obtain a credit refund from QuickCliq.

#### Q. I have credit sitting on my account, how do I get that refunded?

You can obtain a refund of available credit at any time.

- Go to the PROFILE section of your account
- Go to Account Balance Refund and Close Account section
- Elect if you would like to close your account and receive a full balance refund OR request a refund from your existing account balance.

#### Notes:

Please allow up to 5 Business days for the refund to be completed.

QuickCliq aim to refund via the original means of payment. If this should not be possible, QuickCliq will contact you to arrange an alternative method

For Credit Card refunds users must allow funds to have settled on the account before a refund can be issued. This can take 24 hours.

#### Solar Panels

Over the school holidays, our school should be having new solar panels fitted. For this reason our school will not be participating in the Share our Space initiative in the April school holidays.





# Harmony Day

Last Thursday we celebrated Harmony Day. Unfortunately the dance teacher for Footsteps was sick and unable to attend on the day for our final dance lesson. To make up for the missed lesson, Footsteps will be attending this Wednesday where students will participate in their final dance lesson and then showcase their dance to the rest of the school.

Last Thursday our students looked wonderful all dressed in orange. They participated in Harmony Day activities in class and learnt about what Harmony Day is and why we celebrate it.

## What is Harmony Day

Harmony Day is a celebration of our cultural diversity – a day of cultural respect for everyone who calls Australia home. It is a time to celebrate Australian multiculturalism, and the successful integration of migrants into our community. Australia is one of the most successful multicultural countries in the world and we should celebrate this and work to maintain it.

Harmony Week is about inclusiveness, respect and belonging for all Australians, regardless of cultural or linguistic background, united by a set of core Australian values. Held every year in March, Harmony Day coincides with the United Nations International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination.

**Why orange?** Orange is the colour chosen to represent Harmony Week. Traditionally, orange signifies social communication and meaningful conversations. It also relates to the freedom of ideas and encouragement of mutual respect.





## Cross Country

On Tuesday 28th March (Week 10) we will be holding our school Cross Country Carnival. In case of wet weather, we will have a backup date of Tuesday, 4th April (Week 11).

This is a compulsory event and all students will be participating on the day. Our school focus for PE this term is Cross Country and all students have had the opportunity to practice leading up to our event.

Students from K-6 will be participating in rotational activities throughout the day, including visits from the Port Kembla Cricket Club, NRL and Wollongong City Lifeguards. Students will be completing these rotations in either their age group (8, 9, 10, 11, 12/13 year olds) or year group at school (Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 students who are not 8 years old this year) and will remain in these groups throughout the day. Students who are 8, 9 or 10 years old this year will be running 4 laps of the cross country course and students who are 11 or 12/13 years old this year will be running 6 laps. Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 students who are not competing will be completing 1 lap of the course.

On the day we are inviting parents/carers to attend a picnic lunch with their child/ren. We will hold an extended lunch from 1:20-2:00pm.

## K-2 Easter Hat Parade

We are excited to invite you to join us for the K-2 Easter Hat Parade on Thursday 6 April 2023. The parade will begin at 2pm under the COLA (next to the canteen). The gates will be open at 1.50pm for you to enter the school. Please arrive as close to 1.50pm as possible, as it is the students' lunch break until 1.45pm.

During the parade, the children will have the opportunity to showcase the Easter hats/ crowns that they have made. We encourage students to make an Easter hat/ crown at home and bring it with them on the day (please label hats with your child's name). Easter hats/crowns can be simple and made from things around the home, such as cardboard. Old hats or cheap ones from a discount store are also a great option to use as a base and decorate. Some easy hat ideas/inspiration are included below.

At 2:00pm, Kindergarten students will compete in their Cross Country race and all students in Years 1-6 will return to their classrooms for the remainder of the day. Should you wish to take your child home after this time, can you please see your child's classroom teacher to sign them out, not the office.

Students are encouraged to wear their house colours (Bass = Red, Flinders = Green, Oxley = Blue, Wentworth = Yellow) on the day and school hat and pack plenty of food and water.
